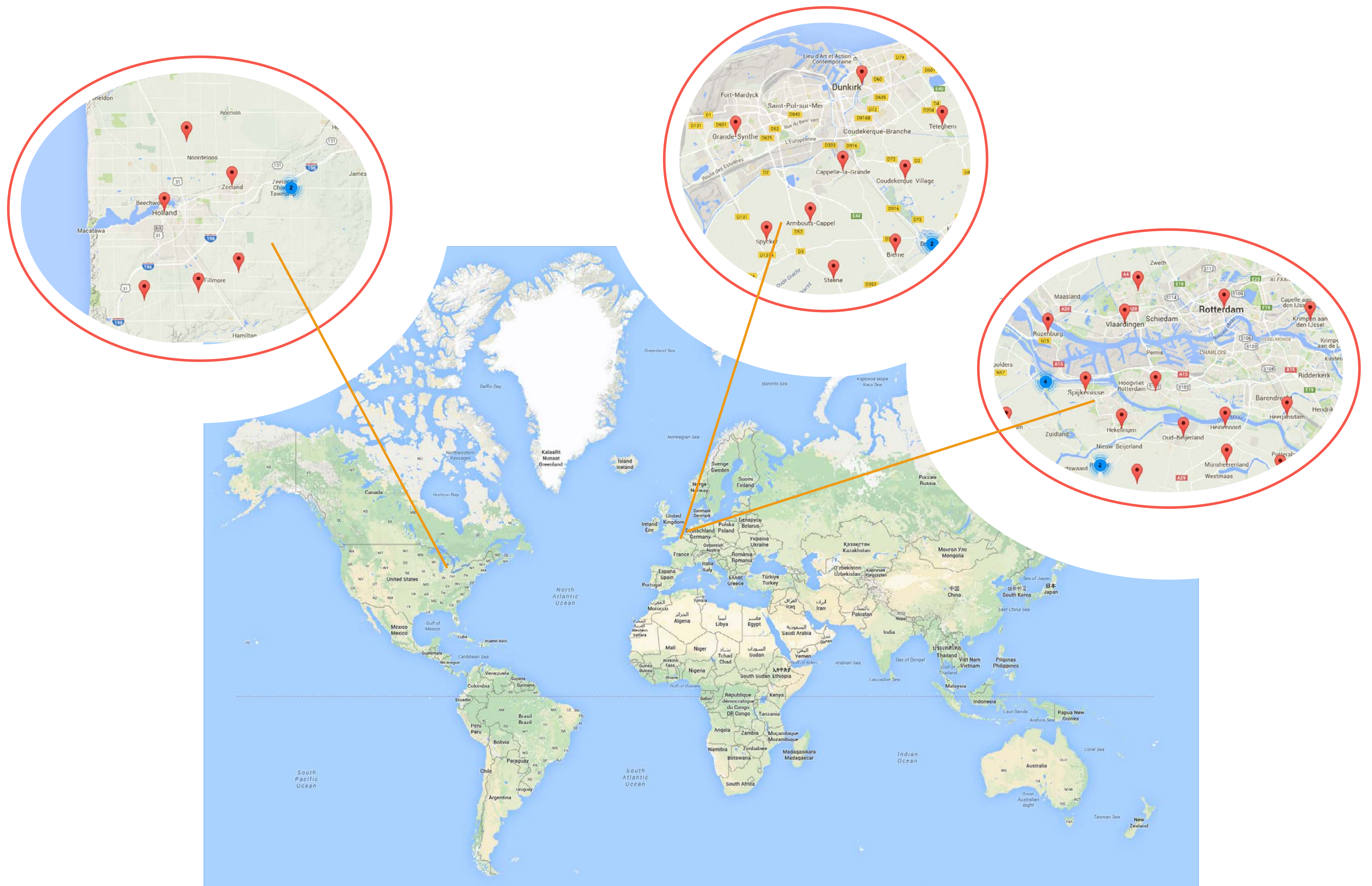


Dutch Dialect Database

The Dutch Dialect Database contains over 2500 recordings of Dutch dialects. In total 839 hours. The recordings are from (among other countries): the Netherlands, Belgium, France and the USA. Accompanying documentation, such as transcriptions (more than 10.000 scans), scans of questionnaires and information about the recordings, has been added to the web interface as well. The entire collection is CLARIN (Common Language Resources and Technology Infrastructure) compatible and available via the CLARIN website. The Meertens Institute continues working on the Dutch Dialect Database. New resources, such as Dutch spoken in Brazil, will be added soon.
